

DAILY BUILDINGS & GROUNDS CHECKLIST

Purpose: Providers may use this form to document daily building and grounds checks.

Directions: To complete this form, staff will complete each section to document the area that was checked each day the child-care operation provides care.

Environment is free of objects that may cause choking in children under 3 years					
Machine washing cloth toys, if used, at least weekly and when contaminated					
Machine washing all linens at least weekly, and when soiled or before another child uses them					
Sanitizing sleeping equipment before a different child uses it and when soiled					
All garbage inaccessible					
All floors, ceilings, and walls in good repair and clean					
All parts of the child-care center used by children well heated, lighted, and ventilated					
Sanitizing table tops, furniture, and other similar equipment used by children when soiled					
Using, storing, and disposing of hazardous materials as recommended by the manufacturer					
Electrical outlets accessible to a child younger than five years must have childproof covers or safety outlets					
Glass in sliding doors must be clearly marked with decals or other materials placed at children's eye level					
Play materials and equipment must be safe and free from sharp or rough edges and toxic paints					
All bodies of water inaccessible to all children					
Active play space and equipment inspected for hazards before children are present					
Broken equipment removed or repaired					
Current menu posted					
Current activity plans posted					
All toxic and cleaning supplies out of child's reach					
Toilet paper available					П
Soap and disposable towels available					
Naptime lighting is appropriate for supervision of all children					
Provide caregivers with enough space to walk and work between cribs, cots, and mats					
Nap mats arranged so that each child and caregiver has access to a walkway without having to walk on or over the cots or mats of other children					
All televisions must be anchored, so they cannot tip over
