

Master List of Dough, Slime, Goo, and Oobleck Recipes

Basic Dough

Take precautions when preparing this recipe as it involves the use of hot water

2 cups of flour

2 Tbsp of oil (vegetable, olive or coconut is fine)

½ cup of salt

2 Tbsp cream of tartar

1 ½ cups boiling water

Mix the dry ingredients well. Slowly add the oil and boiling water and mix. Allow the mixture to cool down and knead until it achieves the desired consistency.

Silky Dough

1 cup hair conditioner

2 cups corn starch

Food coloring

Mix all ingredients until a silky dough forms.

Easy Cola Dough

1 ¼ cups flour

2 Tbsp salt

½ cup cola

Knead until combined.

3 Bears Dough

Take precautions when preparing this recipe as it involves the use of hot water

2 cups plain flour

1 cup salt

2 tablespoons oil

2 tablespoons cream of tartar

2 cups of boiling water

1-2 cups of oats

Mix in the dry ingredients, add the oil and stir through. Carefully add the boiling water and stir well. Let the dough cool and knead it until it is no longer sticky. Add the oats and knead until it is the desired consistency.

Gluten Free Dough

1 cup baby rice cereal

1 cup of Cornstarch

1/2 cup unsweetened applesauce

3 Tablespoons of vegetable oil

Food coloring

Combine well.

Sparkly Slime

Mix equal parts clear school glue, water and liquid starch along with several drops of food coloring and a few shakes of glitter. Combine well until it turns into slime.

Fluffy Slime

½ cup shaving cream

¼ cup liquid starch

3 TBSP school glue

Food coloring

Combine all ingredients until you get a fluffy slime.

Gingerbread Man Slime

2 cups of white school glue

1 1/2 cups hot water

Ground cinnamon

Buttons

Googly eyes

Combine the glue, hot water and cinnamon until it creates a slimy mess. Pour out onto the table and include buttons and googly eyes for children to shape into a gingerbread man.

Basic Slime

1 cup liquid starch

1 cup white school glue

Food Coloring

Mix ingredients together in a ziplock bag until a firm slime forms.

Basic Oobleck

Corn Starch

Water

Food coloring (optional)

Combine desired amounts of each ingredient to make oobleck!

Scented Oobleck

Corn Starch

Water

Food coloring (optional)

Choose one of the following additives for scent:

Peppermint extract

Vanilla extract

Coconut extract

Almond extract

Pumpkin pie spice

Cinnamon

Mix desired corn starch and water with 1/2 teaspoon of extract or a few shakes of spices to get the desired consistency of oobleck.

Firework Oobleck

Corn Starch

Water

Fizzy colored bath tablets cut into small chunks

Put tablets in a pan and cover with pre-mixed oobleck.

Classic Goo

Take precautions when preparing this recipe as it involves the use of hot water

10 cups water

2 cups cornstarch

Food coloring

Boil the cornstarch and water mixture in a large pot until it becomes a big goopy mess. Add food coloring and mix well. Transfer to a big bowl and allow to cool completely. Play!

Bouncy Ball Goo

Take precautions when preparing this recipe as it involves the use of hot water

2 cups baking soda

1 ½ cups water

1 cup corn starch

Food coloring

Combine all ingredients over medium heat, stirring constantly until mixture boils. After ingredients combine with no lumps, turn out onto a large cutting board and allow to cool. Knead until dough forms.
