Shaken baby – abusive head trauma video script:

- Shaken Baby Syndrome is a preventable and severe form of physical child abuse that results in an injury to the brain of an infant or small child.
- caused by a larger person violently shaking a baby or by blunt impact to a baby's head.
- Even though the shaking may last only a few seconds, it can result in severe injury or death.
- Is the leading cause of physical child abuse deaths in children under 5 in the United States.
- Abuse accounts for approximately one-third of all child maltreatment deaths.
- Is most commonly triggered by inconsolable crying.
- Puts babies less than one-year old at the greatest risk of injury.
- About 25% of all shaking victims die.
- Shaking a baby may cause internal injuries to the brain that leave no visible signs.
- It's normal for babies to cry two to four hours a day.
- Think about how you will stay calm if you've tried everything and the baby is still crying.
